

US Concludes Trump's First SPR Purchase. The Trump administration has <u>finalized</u> its first purchase of crude for the US Strategic Petroleum Reserve, buying 900,000 barrels of sour crude from global trading giant Trafigura and US midstream firm Energy Transfer at an average price of \$62 per barrel.

Nigeria Drops Fuel Import Tariff Drive. Nigeria's government has <u>scrapped</u> its plans to impose a 15% import duty on all refined products, citing assurances of adequate supply during the yearend holidays, amidst retailer protests that it would leave them dependent on the Dangote refinery.
