Petroleum Products Monthly Price Circular

June 18, 2026


New Price Ceiling for Petroleum Products (gasoline and fuel oil) on the Liberian Market Effective June 18, 2026.

The Ministry of Commerce and Industry, in close consultation with the management of the Liberia Petroleum Refining Company (LPRC), has announced a reduction in the prices of both PMS (gasoline) and AGO (fuel oil). The prices have decreased by fifteen United States cents (US\$0.15) and thirty United States cents (US\$0.30), respectively.


